Major Evans was born in Russellville, AL and was raised in Thomasville, NC. He went to Pfeiffer University in Misenheimer, NC and went to Marine Corps Officer Candidate School in October 2008.

Following the Basic School and Manpower Officer Course, Major Evans was assigned as the Adjutant to 2d Combat Engineer Battalion at Camp Lejeune, NC. He was then transferred in December of 2010 to the G-1, 2d Marine Division where he served as the Division Adjutant and Casualty Cell OIC. Early 2011, he was reassigned to Headquarters Battalion as the Battalion Adjutant and served in that billet until his End of Active Service in December 2012.

Upon moving to Knoxville, TN for his civilian occupation, he served as a 2nd Platoon Commander at Lima Company, 3d Battalion, 24th Marines until April 2013. He dropped to the Inactive Ready Reserve until 2015. In December 2015, He was assigned as the Adjutant for Intel Support Battalion, Force Headquarters Group and also served as the H&S Company XO, and New Orleans Detachment Officer In Charge until April 2017. In April 2017, Major Evans was reassigned to 4th Marine Division as the Aide de Camp on Active Duty Operational Support orders till May 2018. In May 2018, Major Evans was activated as the Battalion Adjutant for UDP 19.1 until June 2019.

Upon returning from deployment, Major Evans was assigned as an Inspector, 4th Marine Division in which he currently serves in a reserve status.

Major Evans' personal awards include the Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal and the Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (2d Award).

Major Evans is engaged to Ms. Kaitlyn Fiore of Millburn, NJ. He and his fiancé reside in Ladson, SC with their two dogs, Baxter and Ruger.
